



Baggage Policy

Baggage Policy (General Service) for Thai Airways International Public Company Ltd.

General Information

Baggage allowance determination and checked baggage option apply through checked from the point of departure to the point of arrival without stopover at any of intermediate points. If passenger takes a stopover at an intermediate point, a new assessment of baggage allowance and baggage charge, if applicable, will be measured from the point of departure following the stopover.

Application to Thai Airways International Public Company Ltd.

When passengers travel with Thai Airways for domestic and international flights, passengers allowed carrying free of charge baggage which may include extra charge and subject to the conditions and limitations in THAI regulations.

Standard Free Baggage Allowance

The piece concept allowance is applied by THAI across its global network for a journey:

For travel commencing on or after **02 March 2026**, a new baggage policy based on the Piece Concept will be implemented for the following routes:

- Wholly within Thailand Domestic sector
- A journey within TC3 (Asia, Australia, New Zealand)
- A journey between TC2 (Europe, Africa, Middle East) and TC3 (Asia, Australia, New Zealand)

For travel commencing on or after **02 March 2026**, a new baggage policy based on the Piece Concept will be implemented for the following routes:

- A journey between TC3 (Asia, Australia, New Zealand) and TC1 (North America, South America)

Checked Baggage – Dimension Allowance



For all classes, each checked bag must not exceed a total dimension of 158 cm (62 inches) (height + width + length), including wheels and handles.

Checked Baggage – Weight Allowance



Each piece may weigh up to 32 kg (70 lbs) for Royal First Class, Royal Silk Class, and Premium Economy Plus Class.



Each piece may weigh up to 23 kg (50 lbs) for Premium Economy Class and Economy Class.

High Important

1. When a passenger is involuntarily reissued to a lower class of service, the higher-class baggage allowance shall be applied even though the refund for the fare difference is made.
2. In case of travel on combined services for through journeys where the passenger travels in mixed classes (e.g., partly in C-, U-, or Y-class), the free baggage allowance shall be determined based on the highest class of service for which the fare is paid.
For example, if the passenger has paid a C-class fare but travels partly in U-, or Y-class, the C-class baggage allowance shall apply.
3. One (1) foldable stroller, car seat, or wheelchair may be loaded in the aircraft at no additional charge, limited to one (1) piece per passenger, provided it is required for the passenger's use (e.g., wheelchair for passengers who are elderly, ill, or have a disability). No weight or size restrictions apply to this item. If it does not meet the above conditions (e.g., more than one (1) piece or not required for the passenger's use), it will be treated as normal baggage and the applicable baggage rules will apply.
4. Baggage must be properly packed to prevent damage. Thai Airways reserves the right to refuse acceptance as checked baggage if it is not properly packed.



INTERNATIONAL SECTOR

Checked baggage policy by Piece Concept applicable to international sectors within TC3, between TC2 and TC3, between TC2 and TC1, between TC3 and TC1.

High Important

1. When a passenger is involuntarily reissued to a lower class of service, the higher-class baggage allowance shall be applied even though the refund for the fare difference is made.
2. In case of travel on combined services for through journeys where the passenger travels in mixed classes (e.g., partly in F-, C-, U-, or Y-class), the free baggage allowance shall be determined based on the highest class of service for which the fare is paid.
For example, if the passenger has paid a F-class fare but travels partly in C-class, the F-class baggage allowance shall apply.
3. One (1) foldable stroller, car seat, or wheelchair may be loaded in the aircraft at no additional charge, limited to one (1) piece per passenger, provided it is required for the passenger's use (e.g., wheelchair for passengers who are elderly, ill, or have a disability). No weight or size restrictions apply to this item. If it does not meet the above conditions (e.g., more than one (1) piece or not required for the passenger's use), it will be treated as normal baggage and the applicable baggage rules will apply.
4. Baggage must be properly packed to prevent damage. Thai Airways reserves the right to refuse acceptance as checked baggage if it is not properly packed.
5. If your journey involves multiple airline partners, please be aware that baggage rule may vary. In case of code-share flights, the carrier performing as the Most Significant Carrier (MSC) determines the baggage rule, will be the Marketing Carrier unless that carrier publishes a rule stipulate that it will be the Operation Carrier. In some cases, the baggage rule that applied for your journey may those of our partner airlines. For more details, please refer to the IATA resolution 302 according to attached document and link provided.

Excess Baggage Policy

Applicability: This policy applies to all passenger who check in baggage exceeding the standard free baggage allowance defined by number of pieces, weight, or size (dimension) based on cabin class, fare brand, and frequent flyer tier, including:

- Airport - purchased excess baggage at check in counter and TG airport ticketing office.
- Prepaid excess baggage - purchased online, via call center, TG city ticketing office, or agent at least 24 hours before the scheduled departure time before first flight segment.

Additional Piece: When purchasing an additional piece, the dimension must not exceed 158 cm (62 inch) and the following maximum weight per piece applies, based on the cabin class.

- First/ Business class: Additional Piece (Max Weight) 32 kg per piece.
- Premium Economy/ Economy class: Additional Piece (Max Weight) 23 kg per piece.



Pricing: Flat rate by Zone applies as follows:

- **Rate apply per piece by zoning basis:** Defined geographical group of destination countries.
- **Overweight & Oversized Charges:** if any checked-in baggage or an excess piece exceeds the standard weight or dimension allowance (23/32 kg or 158 cm linear) limits per piece, overweight or oversized charges will be collected at the airport based on the applicable Airport Zone Rate.
 - **Overweight**
 - For passengers with a Free Baggage Allowance of 23 kg per piece, overweight charges apply as follows:
 - 23–32 kg:
→ **Charge 1x Airport Zone Rate**
 - For passengers with a Free Baggage Allowance of 32 kg per piece, overweight baggage is not permitted, as the maximum weight per piece is restricted to 32 kg in accordance with labor regulations in certain countries.
 - **Oversized**
 - 158–200 cm (62–79 inches):
→ **Charge 1x Airport Zone Rate**
 - 200–330 cm (79–130 inches) (Bulky Baggage):
→ **Charge an additional 1x Airport Zone Rate**
- **Conditions: Non-refundable, including both partial and full refunds.**
