

# REVISION IN FUEL SURCHARGE

## Across All Air India and Air India Express Routes



Dear Travel Partners,

This is to inform you that, owing to the ongoing global fuel crisis, Air India and Air India Express will be implementing an increase and/or addition in Fuel Surcharge (YQ component) across various fare classes. These revisions will apply uniformly to both AI and IX fares.

Please note that IX currently has NIL YQ component in certain markets but will be impacted as per the new changes.

The rollout will be conducted in phases, as detailed below:

- **Phase 1:** Effective **12/03/2026**, the revision will apply to **Domestic India, SAARC, Southeast Asia (SEA), Gulf, Saudi Arabia, and Africa markets.**
- **Phase 2:** Effective **18/03/2026**, the revision will apply to **LHI/MHI** markets, in accordance with the local requirement of 7 days advance notification.
- **Phase 3:** For **Hong Kong, Korea, and Japan**, which require 2-4 weeks advance notice due to regulatory requirements, implementation will take place upon final confirmation from respective Country Managers, latest by **01/04/2026.**
